A guide to Competence in Health & Safety

Chartered Fellow (CFIOSH) & Chartered Member (CMIOSH)

Chartered Fellow and Member of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health, are entitled to use the designation **Chartered Safety and Health Practitioner** and the designatory letters, **CFIOSH**, **CMIOSH**. these categories of membership are the most prestigious and reflect the competence demanded of professionals in health and safety management or leadership positions. All Chartered Fellows and Members need to maintain a Continuing Professional Development (CPD) record.

Graduate IOSH (Grad IOSH)

Graduates of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health can use the designatory letters **Grad IOSH**. The category denotes those who are academically qualified to become Chartered Members, but are currently completing a mandatory IPD / CPD cycle. To qualify for this level of membership, you need to have completed an IOSH accredited qualification.

Technician Member (Tech IOSH)

Technician Member of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health, are entitled to use the designatory letters **Tech IOSH**. This category recognises the competence needed by professionals engaged in crucial operational health and safety roles. A version of CPD specifically tailored to this category is mandatory for Technician Members to maintain their status.

Affiliate

Affiliate level is designed for those who have an interest in, or are employed in occupational safety and health, but are not eligible to join at other categories of membership.
